

2019 ReTees Intro

Welcome back to all returning ReTees, and greetings to those interested in joining!

1) Membership	Membership is open to Boeing employees, retired Boeing employees, and former Boeing Employees. We also allow a certain number of "associate members" who don't need to meet those requirements. Ask an officer if you need more information. We play at Foster Golf Links .
2) League night & starting tee-time	League starting tee-time is reserved for 4:00 pm every Wednesday. Please be there 1/2 hour before your assigned tee time in case earlier spots are available. Pairing sheets with assigned tee-times will be e-mailed out on a weekly basis, as well as posted on our league website.
3) Schedule	We will play 25 weeks starting March 27 thru Sep 4th . The first 4 weeks are informal practice, including an "April Fools" tournament (on April 3rd), and a "Horse Race" on April 10th. This will be followed by two 10-week halves of league, and a playoff / scramble on Sep 11th. We will also have the ReTees Ryder Cup on July 3rd, more info out later.
4) Hole-in-1 Pot (HI1P)	The HI1P has a \$1830 carryover in 2019. Anyone who buys-in (optional choice) to the pot is eligible to win (if he aces) during the 20 regular competition weeks or during the 2 league-sponsored Field Days. See the website to see if you are already IN!
5) Competition	Competition runs 20 weeks. Year-end playoff will be a 9-hole match-play at Foster on September 11th . The winners of each half in each division compete that day starting on hole #1 or #10. The 2 winners of those matches will play in the The Interleague Championship, scheduled for Oct 6th at the Home Course .
6) Dues	Dues will be the same as last year, \$65 (\$60 for retirees & \$58 for anyone's second league). This breaks down to \$25 dues for each half plus \$15 for a BEGA membership. Retirees pay \$10 for BEGA membership. Participants in multiple leagues pay \$8 for each additional league they join. Some of the benefits of belonging to BEGA are reduced fees for GHIN cards, more tournament opportunities, and the end-of- year Interleague tourney (ReTees general fund pays green fees for our 2 representatives). ReTees dues mainly go towards the weekly prize fund, field day prizes/fees, playoff greens fees, officer entry for field days, and league Secretary fees.

7) Foster Green Fees	Projected Foster Summer rates: 9 Holes – Senior is \$19 – Regular \$23, 18 Holes – Senior is \$28 – Regular \$33
8) #6 is a par 5	As in 2018, hole #6 will be played as a par 5. (Just like the Foster Men's Club).
9) #17 is a par 4	As in 2018, hole #17 will be played as a par 4. Use the Black Tees that will be set up, back near the #11 tee-box. Those who input scores into GHIN for the back side should select Men's Club – Back Nine. This will have the proper slope and rating for the tees.
10) ReTees Field Days	3 Field Days are scheduled, two of which are league-sponsored. The 'non-league' tournament will be on May 4th at Glen Acres. The two official ReTees tourneys are currently scheduled for June 8th at Spanaway, and September 8th at Gold Mountain (Olympic side). More info will be provided as the dates approach.
